Please note that if you are sending offers through shipment companies so therefore Offers should be submitted in good time to be received at or before closing time or deadline to WDIO, otherwise it will be not acceptable.

Introduction:

Watan Development and Initiative Organization is a non-governmental, nonprofit, nonpolitical, and independent organization dedicated to empowering and uplifting communities through sustainable development, social justice, and the enhancement of well-being for individuals and families. Since its establishment in 2014, we have tirelessly worked towards poverty alleviation, economic empowerment, education and skill development, health and well-being, gender equality, women's empowerment, agriculture and livestock, and environmental sustainability. Our goal is to improve living conditions, provide quality education and essential skills to individuals, enhance community health and well-being, achieve gender equality, improve agricultural productivity, and promote environmental sustainability.

ITB Purpose & Scope of Work:

WDIO aims to procure reputable supplier to deliver and transport food items, specifically biscuits and vegetable oil, to 1625 distribution points across 11 districts within Ghor province. Suppliers are required to deliver and transport food items from the center of each district to various distribution points within that district. The project duration is nine months, and suppliers are expected to deliver these food items once a month for the duration of the project. All distribution points are located within schools and CBE (Community-Based Education) centers in the specified districts of Ghor province. The project covers 11 districts within Ghor province, namely Pasaband, Tulak, Taiywara, Char Sada, Chighchiran, Murghab, Dawlatyar, Dolaina, Saghar, Shahrak, and Lale-Sarjantal. Deliveries will be made from the center of each district to multiple distribution points within that district. Distribution points are specifically located within schools and CBE centers, emphasizing the importance of reaching educational institutions and community-based educational facilities. WDIO is seeking reputable suppliers, implying a focus on reliability, efficiency, and adherence to quality standards in the delivery and transportation of food items. Suppliers must be capable of managing logistics effectively to ensure timely and efficient delivery to multiple distribution points across the specified districts.

Overall, the ITB outlines the requirements for suppliers to undertake the delivery and transportation of essential food items to support educational and community-based initiatives in Ghor province over a nine-month period.

The supplier shall quote their prices for delivery and transportation of mentioned items per Metric Ton to the mentioned districts distribution points without the loading and off-loading cost.

General Instruction to Bidders:

- The bidder shall have available transportation facility to deliver the mentioned food items to the mentioned places at the provided date and time by WDIO.

- ITB cover letter must be signed by company authorized person. (Use the template in ANNEX “A”)
- Bidders shall complete the Attached Bill of Quantity to submit the quotes, all prices shall be quoted in AFN only. ITB received in any currency other than AFN will be considered nonresponsive.
- In case of price discrepancy between unit price and SUBTOTAL price, the unit price shall prevail.
- The rates quoted shall be for complete service inclusive of all taxes and all charges for service contingent to the work.
- WDIO has the rights to increase or decrease the quantity of mentioned services in this ITB as needed in compliance with the project requirements/description.
- WDIO reserves the right to award the deal to one or several vendors, or no vendors at all, depending upon the needs of the project.
- Incomplete offers or offers which do not comply with any or our tender conditions will not be considered.
- The Bidders shall have similar experience for delivery & Transportation to NGOs or Organization.
- The Bidders shall provide similar experience evidence documents in the form of contracts or purchase orders.
- Bidders shall provide Both Financial & Technical documents in sealed envelopes.
- The Bidder shall have a valid business license to operate in Afghanistan.

Government Contract Withholding Tax:

Pursuant to Article 72 in the Afghanistan Tax Law effective May 2010, WDIO is required to withhold "contractor" taxes from the gross amounts payable to all Afghan for-profit subcontractors/vendors. In accordance with this requirement, WDIO shall withhold two percent (2%) tax from all gross invoices to subcontractors/vendors under this Agreement with active AISA or Ministry of Commerce license. For subcontractors/vendors without active AISA or Ministry of Commerce license, WDIO shall withhold seven percent (7%) "Contractor" taxes per current Afghanistan Tax Law.

Before the signing of this Agreement, the subcontractor/vendor will provide a copy of the organization's AISA or Ministry of Commerce license and TIN (Tax Identification Number). Amounts deducted from the invoices will be forwarded to the Ministry of Finance (MOF) Tax Division credited to the firm's TIN. Records of payments to the MOF shall be maintained on file with WDIO.

Payment Terms & Condition

- Currency of offer should preferably in AFN
- Payment will be made to the supplier within 15 days through bank Cheque or Cash after the delivery and transportation of food items but it is related to the project installments as well, whenever the installments of the project delayed it will also affect the payment transfer process.
- WDIO will not be responsible for any bank service charges.
- WDIO does not undertake to pay by letter of credit or in advance of delivery.

Termination of Agreement:

WDIO shall have the right to terminate this Agreement at any time by a written notice to the Contractor whenever the contractor does not perform its activities in accordance with the contract or is not acceptable to the WDIO, the management of WDIO has the authority to terminate the contract.

Conflict of Interest Declaration:

The following steps outline WDIO Contracts selection process and should be understood by all Bidders to ensure the transparency of awards and avoid conflict of interest.

- Once the quotations are received, Cost offers are evaluated for reasonableness, accuracy, and completeness.
- The best value offer is selected based on a combination of the technical score and the cost.
- No activity can be started until vetting and other formalities are completed and both WDIO and the awardee have signed a formal contract.
- At no time is it appropriate or legal for contractors or beneficiaries to offer any WDIO staff member commissions, kickbacks, or gifts of any kind. If a WDIO employee is found taking commissions, kickbacks, gifts or engaging in fraud of any kind their employment contract with WDIO will be immediately terminated and their actions will be reported to Donor, the offer of the bidder will be also rejected.
- The supplier may report unethical, illegal, and corrupt practice to WDIO directorate.
